INDUSTRIAL MUILT-SECTOR GENERIC PERMIT (MSGP) QUICK **FACTS**

NPDES STORMWATER PERMITTING PROGRAM FOR INDUSTRIAL ACTIVITY

During a rainfall event, stormwater can move across industrial facilities collecting sediment, debris, chemicals, and other pollutants along the way. Without proper best management controls, these pollutants can be carried off site and harm local waterways, ecosystems, and nearby communities. The MSGP establishes the measures needed to prevent these impacts.

KEY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE FDEP MULTI-SECTOR GENERIC PERMIT

- Secure the appropriate MSGP based on facility criteria and eligibility for FDEP stormwater permits.
- Develop and keep an up-to-date Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP).
- Implement effective best management control; BMPs.
- Perform routine quarterly inspections and maintain all compliance documentation.
- Train employees in stormwater pollution prevention practices.
- Submit required Quarterly Visual Monitoring (QVM) and Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMR) reports to adhere to all FDEP permit conditions.

MAINTAIN COMPLIANCE

- Install appropriate good housekeeping.
- Keep BMPs in good working condition through regular maintenance.
- Education with effective signage.
- Proper Handling of Hazardous Materials
 - Report or clean up any spills seen on-site.
 - Regular disposal of waste.
 - Minimizing material exposure to precipitation.
 - Use double-walled tanks and drip pans to collect and contain hazardous materials.
 - Designated storage areas holding tanks for liquid wastes.
- Document everything
 - Maintain logs for inspections, corrective actions, maintenance, training, spills, and monitoring.
 - Perform required monitoring
 - Collect and analyze benchmark samples, compliance samples, and visual assessments.
